## Salient Security Features of Cheques


- cheques contains invisible ultra violet security feature. only if the cheque is placed against a light source. Further, the paper used for All cheques carry bank's logo or name as a standardized watermark visible
- Cheque books are prepared on special paper approved by Pakistan Security Printing Corporation.
- contain anti forgery ink. The space on the cheques allocated for the amount and name of payee
- Name of the accountholder is printed using Bleed through technology



## Cheque Standardization Features:

- The standard length and height of the cheque lies between 17 to 18 cm and 7 cheque font size lies between 8 to 9 points to 8.5 cm respectively, while the weight of cheque is between 80-90 GSM. The
- The *logo of the bank* is printed on top left of the cheque. The standard height of the logo lies between 0.5 to 1 cm and length from 4 to 5 cm respectively.
- ω The bank name is mandatory along with branch address / code and city to be written under the name of the bank having length from 7 to 8 cm.
- The cheque number is printed on the extreme upper right side of the cheque above the date field
- The date field is located on the upper right side of the cheque. The accepted printed in lucid background. Any kind of slashed or other symbols are not numeric representation for the date field on cheques is DDMMYYYYY and is permitted between elements of the date
- 6 The payee's name starts with the phrase "Pay" and ends with the phrase "or bearer" in the designated space by horizontal marked lines.





- 00 For Pak Rupee cheque, amount in figure is preceded by PKR within of special characters like commas, decimals and slashes are not used. For convenience amount scan area. Any type of alphabetic characters or any type preceded by the amount in figure. foreign currency cheque, the relevant currency symbol appears in place of PKR
- 9. Cheque book carries IBAN (24 digits) as mentioned vide PSD circular No. 2 of
- 10. The payers name must appear on cheque below IBAN.
- The signature line area is located in the lower right area of the cheque. 'signature' is mentioned under signature line.




